CyberMed EHR is compliant with §170.315(b) (10) Electronic Health Information Export by generating C-CDA 2.1 electronic documents. The HL7 Consolidated Clinical Document Architecture (C-CDA) is an XML-based markup standard that provides a library of CDA[®] formatted documents. This document outlines how to use CyberMed to export patient records compliant with 170.315(b) (10).

Rights Management to Generate C-CDA:

Rights must be assigned to generate C-CDA from a facility "admin" account from Control Panel > Security Configuration > Edit User > Click the selected user to see the role assignment as shown in the screenshot below:
